POLICE WARN OF FRAUD SCAMS

- GRANDPARENT CALLS

Caller will convince the victim that they are their grandchild. They will claim to be in trouble, such as arrested and will ask the victim to wire money.

Scam preys on the victim not thinking clearly because they are worried about their grandchild. The caller will usually ask the victim to refrain from calling their parents because they do not want to trouble them. Anytime someone calls and asks for money to be wired, call the police department immediately.

- SWEEPSTAKES SCAM

Caller tells the victim they have won a large sum of money. In order to collect the prize, the victim is told they must pay taxes up front. They will be instructed to mail or wire money for the taxes. A variation is to ask for banking information so money can be wired into the victim's account.

The criminals use this information to steal from the account. Never give out banking or identification information over the phone. A newer variation of this scam involves the caller claiming to be from Medicare and asking for confirmation of the victim's information so a new card can be mailed.

Scams target personal information such as account, routing and credit card numbers. Never respond with this information or reply to a questionable email message.

Recently, emails have been sent from spammers claiming to represent Costco, Fedex and Amazon. The scam email states an order cannot be completed because information has been lost. The email asks the recipient to re-enter the information. Because so many of us order from these legitimate internet services, it is not uncommon for someone who is actually waiting for a delivery to assume this email is real. Even if you are expecting a delivery, assume this email is a fraud and confirm your order by directly contacting the company or the police department.
