IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT BEACHWOOD'S VOTING PRECINCTS

The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections is currently considering newly-proposed precinct boundaries.

If adopted, there would be 9 precincts instead of 10. The vast majority of voters would continue to cast ballots at their same, previous polling locations even though their precinct may have changed. Notification postcards will be sent to all voters whose precincts and/or polling place would change. Additionally, voters will also receive their voter information guides with their precinct and polling location information prior to their next election.

The Board of Elections recently underwent a required cancellation of voter registration records for anyone who has had no voter activity since 2011. MULCH AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS

The City of Beachwood has been producing mulch from the brush collected from our community. Historically, the brush has been double shredded and used on city properties. For the third year, the City is offering mulch to residents for \$2 per bag (2 cubic feet). Mulch can be purchased at the Service Department, 23355 Mercantile Road, Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

CORE CLIMBER ADDED TO BEACHWOOD'S PLAYGROUND

A Core Climber was added to the city's playground. The impressive play structure is the only one of its kind in Northeast Ohio. It offers complex, multi-leveled webbed nets, ropes and perches for children to climb, balance and swing. Features include the Lolliladder, Swiggle Knots and Boogie Board, all designed to enhance muscle and motor development for children ages 5-12.



Located just west of the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center, the city's playground now has four separate play structures, a swing set and a giant sandbox recently filled with 40 tons of new sand.
