LEAVES TODAY... MULCH TOMORROW

The City of Beachwood recycles 100% of all leaves and brush collected.



FALL LEAF PICK-UP

Now through December, leaf trucks are in continuous daily operation throughout the City (weather permitting).

Collection is ongoing from one end of town to the other end of town. There is no need to call for a special pick-up.

Place UNBAGGED leaves on the tree-lawn only. **DO NOT PLACE IN STREET.** Leaf piles mixed with other debris – such as grass – **WILL NOT** be picked up.

After January 1, all leaves need to be bagged. Leaf bags will then be picked up with your regular rubbish on your collection day.

TIPS FOR MANAGING A POWER OUTAGE



If you see a wire down, stay away from it and call 1.888.LIGHTSS (544.4877) or the police or fire department. Never use your stove, gas grill or a heater designed for outdoor use to heat your home. Never use candles around pets or small children. Visit www.firstenergycorp.com for outage maps and useful information.

When restoring service, hazards are restored first and priority goes to hospitals, safety departments and other critical facilities. Repairs are prioritized to restore lines that affect the largest number of customers. Stock up on drinking water and fill bathtubs in advance of a storm.

Text OUT to 544487 to report an outage via text messaging. You can also sign up on the website for outage email or text alerts.
