REINVESTING IN BEACHWOOD

Commerce Park was the forerunner of industrial parks in Northeast Ohio. In 1966, Building I of Commerce Park Square was built.

In 1968, Building II was soon underway and Building III came next in 1971. Commerce Park was built out over the next twenty years with most of the new businesses being industrial and warehousing facilities.

Exciting changes are now happening at the corner of Chagrin and Green.

Residential, retail and service-related businesses are now permitted for the first time within the 190 acre park. "We want to be aggressive when it comes to economic development," says Mayor Merle S. Gordon, "and rejuvenating Commerce Park is part of that vision."

Zoning changes permitting mixed use have paved the way for a major facelift of the park. Late in 2011, the NRP Group, LLC and Munsell Realty Advisors purchased three buildings for \$4.1 million. Demolition of the original buildings began in August. The former Commerce Park Square will soon be replaced by 338 luxury apartments.

The project will feature four courtyards, a pool, grilling areas, a fitness studio and yoga center. Construction is scheduled to begin during early 2013 and occupancy to begin in 2014.

2012 FALL LEAF PICKUP

Beginning Monday, October 1 and running continuously through the second week in December, leaf trucks will be in operation daily throughout the City (weather permitting). Collection is constantly on-going from one end of town to the other end of town. Therefore, there is no need to call for a special pickup.

All you have to do is place UNBAGGED leaves on the tree-lawn only. DO NOT PLACE IN STREET. Leaf piles mixed with other debris – such as grass – WILL NOT be picked up. After December 16, all leaves need to be bagged. Leaf bags will then be picked up with your regular rubbish on your collection day.
