Proclaiming Saturday, November 12, 2016 as
“SANFORD KUTASH DAY”
in the City of Beachwood

- WHEREAS,** The City of Beachwood is pleased to join with the family and friends of **Sanford Kutash**, born November 7, 1926, to wish him a happy 90th Birthday; and
- WHEREAS,** The son of Ethel and Louis Kutash, **Sanford** was joined later by a sister, Beverly. He is a 1945 graduate of Glenville High School and served in the United States Navy from 1945 to 1947 aboard the USS Texas, the only remaining WWI dreadnaught battleship and the first battleship to be declared a US National Historical Landmark; and
- WHEREAS,** In 1949, **Sanford** graduated from Western Reserve University and in 1950 he married Shirley Baumel. **Sanford** began his extraordinary career in insurance in 1958 – which remains on-going even as he turns 90. **Sanford** is father to Mitchell (Sandy), Larry (Jody) and Janice (Gary), and grandfather to seven; and
- WHEREAS,** **Sanford**, a Beachwood resident for forty-five years, was an avid tennis player when younger, is a fifty-year member of the Forest City Masonic Lodge and a life member of the Million Dollar Round Table. A generous philanthropist, **Sanford** has given money to local hospitals and centers including Menorah Park, the Cleveland Clinic and UH Ahuja.
