GENERAL COMMUNITY CENTER INFORMATION:

Beachwood residents and community groups are able to rent Beachwood Community Center rooms for meetings and functions. Each of the center's six rooms may be rented individually or combined to form a larger room. Rooms may be combined to comfortably seat 144 for dinner and up to 250 chairs-only for a lecture.

Prices from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on weekdays range from \$30 an hour to \$100 an hour depending on size of room. Additional fees may be assessed for limited kitchen facilities, necessary police or parking staff and clean-up. All fees including a security deposit of \$200 are due at the time of reservation. Additional rules and regulations may apply, appointment necessary for viewing, call 216-292-1970.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Regular Hours: Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
Reservations must include set-up and take-down. If using any kind of catering or entertainment, please remember their set-up/take-down time must be included. Special premiums apply to usage before and after these posted hours.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

Proof of residency is required at the time of booking. Please note: falsification of proof of residency will result in the forfeiture of all fees. Two (2) forms of proof must be presented for each rental. Examples include: current utility bill and current driver's license or state photo ID with address.

ROOM RENTAL INCLUDES:

Specified room(s), room set-up, tables, chairs and sound system if requested (does not include common areas, lobby, patio space or food service). Kitchen rental (if available) is a separate fee. Complete room rental payment, security deposit and police security/parking lot attendant fee (if applicable) is required at time of booking.

WHO CAN RENT/USE A ROOM WITHOUT A CHARGE:

City of Beachwood sponsored activities, Beachwood Board of Education, Beachwood Arts Council, Beachwood Chamber of Commerce, Government Entities, Home Owners Associations and Non-Profit organizations that directly provide services to the City of Beachwood or its employees.

Civic or community groups with a majority of Beachwood residents or an office within the City limits. Non-Profit/Charitable organizations which have an office in Beachwood or provide services to a significant number of Beachwood residents; must provide a copy of 501 3C status and membership roster (50% of extended fee during extended hours).



GENERAL REFUND POLICY

The decision to maintain classes is based on the enrollment at the first class; refunds are not guaranteed after the first session/class. Participants assume the risk of changes in personal affairs and health. No refund for materials purchased. Classes that are subcontracted may be non-refundable. Each refund request will be submitted for approval on a case-by-case basis. If a session/class was attended, the refund may be subject to a prorated amount. The Recreation Department reserves the right to terminate a class with fewer than the required number of registrants. Programs are subject to change of location and/or personnel. If a program or class is cancelled by our office due to insufficient enrollment participants will receive a full refund. All other refund requests will be subject to a 5% processing fee, no less than \$5 and no more than \$25. with the exception of City Day Camp fees.

DISABLED POLICY

Over the years, many people with various disabilities have participated in Beachwood Recreation programs. If you or a member of your family has an impairment, we want you to know that your participation in Beachwood Recreation programs is encouraged. Staff members are sensitive to your needs and will do everything possible to assist you. Most facilities are accessible to the disabled individual. If you are interested in participating in a program but you're not sure about the accessibility of a facility, please call Beachwood Recreation and ask us about specifics.



ELIGIBILITY

FEES

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Deadlines are used as a tool to determine whether there is enough interest in a class/activity to invest time and money. If a class minimum isn't met by the deadline date, the activity may be cancelled. Does missing the deadline mean I can't get into the class? In some cases, except sports leagues and camps, participants may still be able to register for an activity until the class is filled. But early registration guarantees you and your family members a spot in your favorite activities.

INCLEMENT WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

When the Beachwood City Schools are not in session or are dismissed early due to inclement weather, all daytime, afternoon and/or evening Recreation classes will not be held, regardless of weather changes. Classes missed due to bad weather or other 'acts of God' will be added on to the end of the session whenever possible. Beachwood Recreation however reserves the right to terminate any class with fewer than the scheduled number of sessions, without issuing a refund or a credit. Programs held in other districts (i.e. South Euclid-Lyndhurst) follow their respective building and/or school closing schedules.
