PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND CAMPERS:

Welcome to the Beachwood Kidz Day Camp Summer 2017!

Our camp is scheduled to run from June 12th through July 28th ... that's 34 days and over 200 hours of summer fun, games, field trips and most importantly, great memories!

No camp on Tuesday, July 4th.

Please familiarize yourself with the following rules and procedures designed to guarantee a wonderful camp experience.

MORNING ARRIVAL – CURBSIDE DROP-OFF

Our day begins at 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. Our dropoff will be at the High School main parking lot. You can drop off your child from 9:00-9:15 a.m. We will have adults outside opening doors and escorting your camper inside to camp. If you need to speak to a staff member, please park in the main school parking lot and walk in with your camper. You can always park in the main school parking lot to walk your child inside if preferred.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Our day ends at 3:15 p.m.

We will be doing our curbside pick-up at Shakercrest. Each parent will be given a number for the entire summer to be displayed on your dashboard. All carpools need to have your campers number too. Attached please find your child's pick-up number. Additional copies of your number are available. If you have a camper at Bison Camp and would like them picked-up with your Kidz camper, please let us know. Please remain in your car during pick-up.

CARPOOL

If your child is going home with a friend or has another ride, please send a note to camp in the morning. **We will not permit children to go home with anyone without a written note from the guardian or parent of both children.**

Permission Release of a child: Enclosed is a release form. Please list the people who have permission to take your child home from camp. We ask if your child has a playdate please notify the camp via letter. We will not release your child without written permission.

LATE PICK-UP / AFTER CAMP CHILD CARE

After 3:30 p.m., any camper not picked up will be escorted to Beachwood Recreation After Camp Child Care. On warm days, the After Camp Child Care will be held at the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center. On bad weather days, it will be held at Beachwood High School. A late pick-up fee of \$5 will be charged for every 15 minutes you arrive beyond 3:30 p.m. The late pick-up fee must be paid when picking up your child or before your child returns to camp the following day. No exceptions permitted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Our goal is to provide your child with a safe and caring atmosphere during their time with us. With this goal in mind, it is essential all campers understand the rules and regulations of Kidz Camp. All campers are expected to follow all the rules below:

1. Staff members are to be given proper respect.
2. All campers must stay with their assigned counselor or activities director.
3. All campers should show proper respect to each other as well as their surroundings.
4. Physical violence (i.e. hitting, fighting, throwing, biting, damaging property) and consistent disobedience will not be tolerated. Such action may be grounds for removal from camp and forfeiture of camp fees.
5. All safety rules regarding swimming will apply in and around water.
6. Campers are not to display any disruptive or inappropriate behavior toward any person while at camp. The Beachwood Recreation Office reserves the right to remove any child who consistently disobeys or breaks the rules stated above. This will result in the forfeiture of any camp fees.

We are NOT responsible for any lost or damaged video games or electronics. In an effort to prevent problems we ask that your child leave them at home.

ABSENCES

If a camper will be absent for any reason, please call the Kidz Camp Office BEFORE 9:30 a.m. at (216) 292-1974. Please leave your child's full name, group name and the reason they will not be attending. If absence is due to a communicable disease, please be sure to inform us so we can send home the proper paperwork. If your child is arriving late, please be sure to call as well. All late arrivals need to be walked into the Kidz Camp Office.

MEDICATIONS

If your child requires any medication prescribed by a physician during camp hours, please bring all medication to the Kidz Camp Office. Everything must be properly labeled with dosage and timing instructions.

Medication forms must be completed and on file in both the Kidz Camp Office and the Recreation Office before any medication is distributed. See Camp Director for forms.

Please alert the Camp Director of any allergies both verbally and in writing. If medication is needed for allergies please label the medication and bring it to the Kidz Camp Office.

DAILY SCHEDULE AND CALENDAR

For your reference, attached is a daily schedule of activities. Activities will include art, nature, music, sports and cooking. Please note that activities and times are subject to change. This year we will offer Yoga.

LABELING

Be sure to label towels, backpacks, lunch bags, sunscreen, water bottles and other personal items. (i.e. underwear, socks, hats, etc.).

Send in a labeled zip lock bag with an extra set of clothes for Kindergarteners to keep at camp.

FIELD TRIPS

Attached is a list of planned field trips and special camp events. Campers **MUST** wear socks, tennis shoes and their camp t-shirts on every field trip.

*** Be sure to send lunches in a disposable brown or plastic bag to throw away on field trips.

*** Make sure campers arrive on time on field trip days as buses leave promptly.

A few of our field trips require waivers, please go on-line and complete the waiver previous to field trip dates. If you have already attended the venue you are waived in and do not need to resubmit.
