A RESOLUTION TO GIVE NOTICE OF INTENTION OF CITY COUNCIL TO NOT COLLECT CHARTER MILLAGE IF PASSAGE OF LEVY IS SUCCESSFUL; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the City of Beachwood Schools have proposed a School Tax Levy for the purpose of rebuilding and modernizing elementary schools; and

WHEREAS, if passage of the Levy is obtained, City Council intends to not collect Charter Millage for a period of three years to temper the tax burden on the Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: City Council will adopt their tax budget and will not levy the Charter Millage up to 2.4 mils annually for the next three years if the Levy is successful.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared an urgent measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or the efficient operation of the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
