**2. Discussion regarding License Plate Readers**

Mr. Synenberg introduced this item and turned the discussion over to Chief Dolan.

Chief Dolan gave background information on this item.

Mr. Kaufman discussed a few License Plater Readers (LPR's) that are already in the City.

Mr. Kaufman stated that Motorola has the lowest pricing.

Mr. Synenberg asked about the timeline and Mr. Kaufman stated that he wasn't sure yet and would have a better idea after the LPR's are ordered.

Mr. Kaufman also stated that two LPR's will be installed in our Police Vehicles.

Mr. Isaacson inquired about the lifetime expectancy of these cameras and asked if they will perform well in the dark.

Mr. Kaufman replied that these cameras will come with a five-year warranty and the hope is to get 6 to 7 years out of these LPR's. He also stated that these are 4K cameras and will work well in the dark.

Mr. Isaacson then asked who will have access to these cameras.

Chief Dolan replied that the Police and Safety Director will make that call and stated that parameters can be set up for certain readings.

Ms. Shoykhet then asked how many surrounding cities have these LPR's.

Chief Dolan replied she was unsure of the exact number but stated there are several communities using these cameras.

The Chairman then asked if there were any further questions and there were none.

This item will be placed on the next available agenda for approval.

None.


