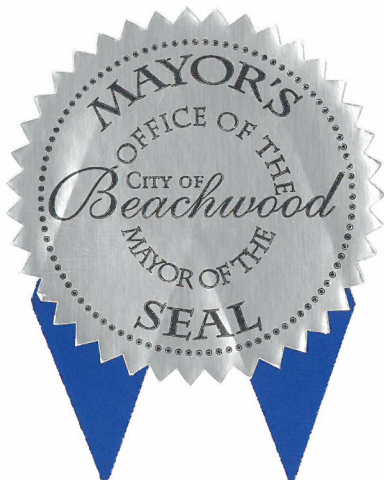
PROCLAMATION
