Citizen Police Academy Preapproval Requirements:

- Be 21 years of age or older
- Have a High School Diploma or GED
- Be a resident of or work in the City or otherwise be a member of the Beachwood community
- Have no pending criminal charges
- Have no felony convictions; misdemeanor convictions will be considered on a case by case basis
- No pending civil litigation against the City, any other municipality, state, or federal government or other governmental or quasi-governmental agencies
- Have personal character consistent with community standards

Background checks are performed and Character references must be provided.

All applicants meeting the requirements for the Academy will be considered. Class size is limited. The City reserves the right to decline any applicant. Participation in and/or successful completion of this Academy DOES NOT provide participants any professional certifications, licenses, other qualifications or give the applicant any right to represent themselves as a member of the Beachwood Police Department. Providing false information on this application will be grounds for non-admittance to or dismissal from the Academy. A signed/witnessed copy of the City of Beachwood Authorization for Release of Information must accompany the application.

REQUIREMENTS (if accepted):

Attendance: Attend the minimum required classes (to be determined) and the final exam. (Classes are tentatively set to take place in the early evening hours during the week.)

Participation: Participate in class discussions and activities, including the handling of firearms and other police equipment.

Evaluation: Pass (75%) a multiple choice exam based on stated Student Performance Objectives.

Notebook: Keep a notebook of Academy documents, Student Performance Objectives, notes, and other items.

Ride-Along: Ride for a minimum of 2 hours with an on-duty Patrolman and report the experience to the Class (to be determined by public health issues).

The Citizen Police Academy is a multi-week program open to residents and other members of the Beachwood community that will open lines of communication, increase cooperation between community members and police officers, and increase participant knowledge of the operation of their police department.

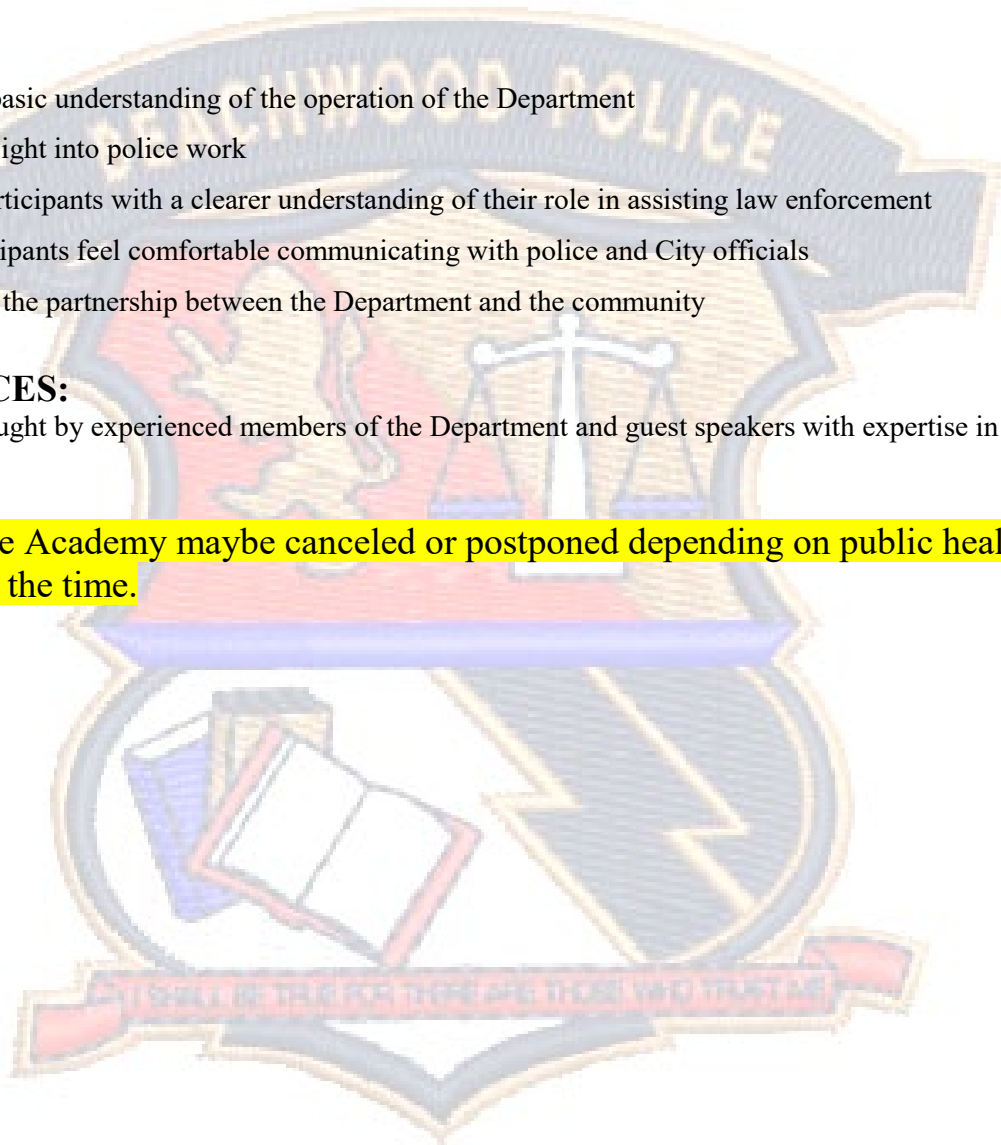
GOALS:

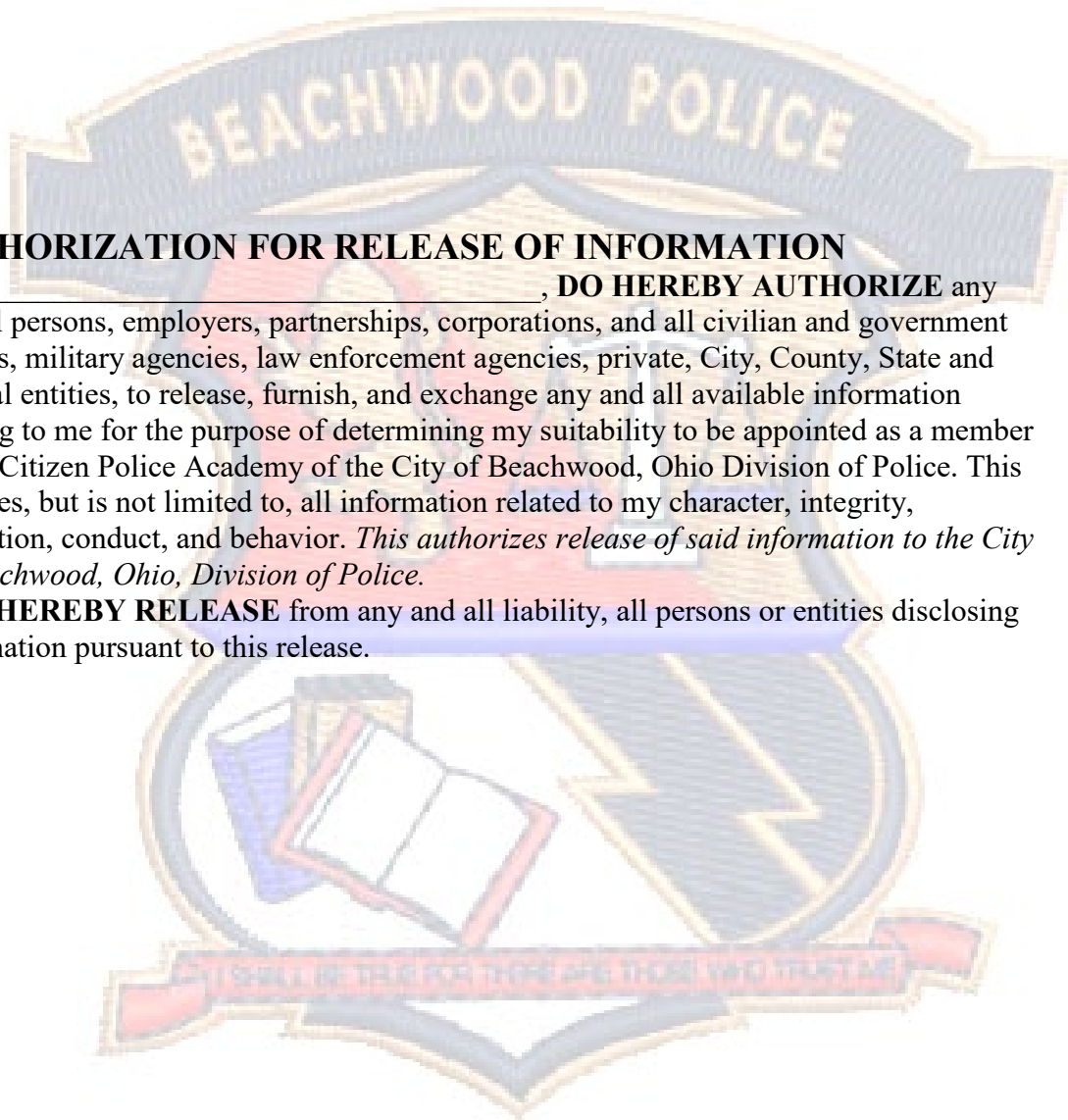
